Regional Ayurveda Research Institute, Ranikhet

Background:

The Regional Ayurveda Research Institute (RARI) under Central Council for Research in Ayurvedic Sciences (CCRAS), Ministry of Ayush, Govt. of India is a premier research Institute in frontier areas for the research on medicinal plants of North-West Himalaya. The Institute was set up for survey of medicinal plants in 1964. Presently, the Institute has two herbal gardens located at Ranikhet (Almora, Uttarakhand) and Chamba (Tehri Garhwal, Uttarakhand) and a Musk Deer Research Centre at Mehruri, Bageshwar. Institute is also offering treatment for various diseases through Ayurvedic medicines at OPD from 5th May 2015 at the institute's Thapla campus.

About Mental Health:

Young professionals, especially those in high-pressure industries, face increasing level of mental health challenges, including stress, anxiety, burnout, and depression. These challenges often arise due to factors like long working hours, job insecurity, poor work-life balance, and societal pressures to succeed. Mental health disorders are arising as alarming public health issue, with young adults often at the highest risk. This population's mental health needs are urgent and require sustainable, holistic solutions to address the root causes rather than just the temporary symptomatic relief. Ayurveda is deeply ingrained in India's cultural heritage and has been recognized by the Ministry of AYUSH (Ayurveda, Yoga, Unani, Siddha, and Homoeopathy) as a key part of the national healthcare strategy.

Mandate of the Institute:

- Medico-Ethno-Botanical Survey of Sub Himalayan Regions.
 Demonstrative Medicinal Plants Garden.
- Musk Deer Breeding.
- Health-care Services through Out Patient Department (OPD) and Panchakarma.

Activities and Achievements of the Institute, Ranikhet:

- Explored different forest divisions covering 54,000 sq. km. approx. area accounting to about 25% of Western Himalaya sheets from Tarai-Bhabar belt to alpine zones.
- It has so far made a collection of 64012 herbarium representing about 218 families, 1410 genera and 3670 species of Angiosperms, Gymnosperms and Pteridophytes.
- New records made on occurrence of Indian Ginseng (*Panax pseudo ginseg* Wall) and an Orchid (*Diplomeris hirsute* Lindl.) from Western Himalaya.
- Plants like Wallichia densiflora Mart and Phrynium placentarium (Lour) Meer considered diminished for about a century have been rediscovered and collected.
- Herbal wealth of Uttarakhand has been compiled and published.
- With the Acronym 'RKT' the Institute's herbarium has been recognized by the New York Botanical Garden, USA. Collected information on more than 550 medicinal folk claims.
- Five book/monographs have been published.
- Institute is offering treatment through NABH affiliated
- Ayush Entry level centre for Ayurveda services.
