INTRODUCTION OF THE COURSE

A critical aspect of the scientific process is the reporting of new results in Scientific Journals in order to disseminate information to the larger community of scientists. Communication of the results contributes to the pool of existing knowledge. Often it provides scientific knowledge for future research. Communicating research findings in peer-reviewed journal is a prerequisite skill for every public health personnel. This course is designed to help health professionals to document their researches. The learning from the training will upgrade their skills to effectively communicate their research findings.

GENERAL OBJECTIVE

To be able to write a research paper/manuscript for publication in a peer reviewed journal.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- To discuss the process of writing research documents/ reports for publication.
- To demonstrate and write various sections of a scientific paper/report precisely.
