- Title page should contain Title of paper, full name of authors with designation, Institute's name, postal address, email ID, contact number, Presenter's name.
- **Word Limit**- 300 words (excluding title and keywords).
- Font style, Font size, and Spacing - Times New Roman, font size 12 for body, 14 for title, spacing 1.5.
- **Format**- Structured format in Microsoft Word in IMRaD format.
- Title should be clear and precise, written in bold, with the first letter of each word capitalized.
- No references are to be included in abstract.
- Graphs, Tables, and Images not to be included in the abstract.
- **Submission**- Only through Official email id - seminar.neiah@gmail.com. Submission of abstract by any other means will not be accepted.
- Incomplete abstract will not be accepted.
- **Last date of submission**: 07/03/2026.
- Registration details should be sent through Google form.
- Abstract of registered delegates will only be accepted for oral/ poster presentation.

ABOUT NEIAH


- North Eastern Institute of Ayurveda and Homoeopathy (NEIAH) is an Autonomous Institute, under the Ministry of AYUSH, Govt. of India, located at Mawdiangdiang, Shillong, Meghalaya. The Institute has been established by the Ministry of AYUSH, Govt. of India, with the aim to impart Graduate, Post-graduate, Doctoral, and Research Programmes in Ayurveda and Homoeopathy, and also provide quality medical facilities and act as referral hospitals. At present, the Institute is running one College of Ayurveda & one College of Homoeopathy offering undergraduate courses in BAMS (Bachelor of Ayurvedic Medicine Surgery) & BHMS (Bachelor of Homoeopathic Medicine & Surgery) and Post Graduation (PG) Course in Homoeopathy & Post Graduation (PG) Course in Ayurveda. This institute has started its undergraduate program (BAMS & BHMS) in 2016 and Post Graduation (PG) Course in Homoeopathy from 2023, & Post Graduation (PG) Course in Ayurveda from 2025. The Institute frequently organizes National Seminars, Regional Seminars, webinars and CME's for Faculty members / Medical officers in addition to various outreach activities (Free Health camps/ Health awareness program). Prominent Scholars of Ayurveda, Homoeopathy, Yoga, and Bio-medical Research field are invited time to time for Guest Lectures for the benefit of students.

ABOUT SHILLONG

- Shillong, the 'Scotland of the East', is the capital of Meghalaya (Abode of the Clouds), and is 120 km from Guwahati airport and 100 km from Guwahati railway station. The best tourist attractions in Shillong and nearby areas are Cherrapunji (Sohra), Mawsynram, Dawki River, Laitlum, Golf Course, Don Bosco Museum, Elephant Falls, Ward's Lake, Umroi Lake, and the Krangshuri waterfall. The temperature of Shillong in February will be 15°C – 22°C.
- NEIAH is 42 km (1 hour) from Shillong Airport. Participants may also come through the Guwahati Airport/ Railway Station, which connects to the city via a scenic uphill drive. Shillong is the educational and cultural heartbeat of the region, often celebrated as the "Rock Capital of India" due to its deep-rooted passion for western music and arts.
- Shillong is situated amidst rolling pine-covered hills and colonial-era charm. Visitors can explore the bustling Police Bazar, a melting pot of local culture and heritage. Meghalaya is renowned for its Living Root Bridges, a marvel of bio-engineering by the Khasi tribes. The "Mawphlang Sacred Grove," famous for preserving ancient biodiversity, is only 25 km from the city, offering a serene backdrop for the seminar.

HOW TO REACH

NEAREST INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT - LOKPRIYA GOPINATH BORDOLOI INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT, GUWAHATI

Nearest major airport is 'Lokpriya Gopinath Bordoloi International Airport' (IATA: GAU, ICAO: VEGT), Guwahati, Assam which is well connected to all parts of India and some of the South-East Asian Countries. It is about 114 km from Police Bazar, Shillong and one can hire a cab from the airport to reach here.




BY RAILWAY - GUWAHATI RAILWAY STATION

Nearest major railway station is 'Guwahati Railway Station' (Station code: GHY), Guwahati, Assam, which is well connected to major cities in India via an extensive rail network. From outside the station, travellers can hire a taxi or cab to reach Shillong.



NEAREST DOMESTIC AIRPORT - SHILLONG AIRPORT

Shillong Airport (IATA: SHL, ICAO: VEBI) is a domestic airport serving Shillong, the capital of Meghalaya, India. It is located at Umroi, and one can hire local cab to reach Marriott Hotel, Police Bazar (about 24 kms via NEHU road). It provides flight services from Aizawl, Dimapur, Guwahati, Dibrugarh, Lilabari, Silchar, Agartala, Kolkata.
