(Note: 09.10.2026 (5.00 P.M.) is the last date/ closing date for submission of Registered online Application)* for recruitment to **32 (Thirty-Two) posts of Ayurvedic Medical Officer of Odisha Ayurvedic Medical Service under Health & Family Welfare Department** in the scale of pay of Rs. 44,900/- (Level 10, Cell -1 of Pay Matrix under Rule-3 of the ORSP Rules, 2017), with usual Dearness and other Allowances as may be sanctioned by the Government of Odisha from time to time.

2. VACANCY POSITION:

As per requisition furnished by the Health & FW Department, Government of Odisha, out of a total of **32 (09-w) vacancies**, 02 vacancies are for UR category, 12(04-w) vacancies are reserved for SEBC category, 16(05-w) vacancies are reserved for SC category and 02 vacancies are reserved for ST category.

Also, 01 post is reserved for Person with Disabilities whose permanent disability is 40% or more.

Candidates belonging to the categories of PWD shall be adjusted against the categories to which they belong.

3. AGE:

A candidate must have attained the age of **21(twenty-one)** years and must not be above the age of **42 (forty-two)** years on the **1st day of January, 2026** i.e., he/she must have been born **not earlier than 2nd January, 1984 and not later than 1st January, 2005.**

4. EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:

A candidate must have possessed Bachelor Degree in Ayurvedic Medicine and Surgery (BAMS) or any other equivalent Degree from a recognized University or Institution recognized by the Central Council of Indian Medicine and must have registered himself/ herself under the Odisha State Council of Ayurvedic Medicines.

5. EXAMINATION FEE:

The candidates other than SC, ST, and PwD category shall have to pay the examination fee amounting to **Rupees Seven Hundred (₹700/-) only** through online mode while filling the Online Application Form. The examination fees paid shall be refunded only to those candidates who actually appear in both the papers of Written Examination. Application without payment of examination fees (except SC/ ST/ PwD candidates) will be taken as incomplete and outrightly be rejected.

Refund shall be issued in due course after completion of the Written Examination. Refund will be processed to the original mode of payment used at the time of the transaction by the candidate. (Credit Card, Debit Card, UPI, Net Banking, Wallet etc.)

6. METHOD OF SELECTION:

The selection of candidates for recruitment to the posts of Ayurvedic Medical Officer shall be made on the basis of **Written Examination (Objective type) in accordance with the syllabus as specified in Odisha Ayurvedic Medical Service (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 2013 and its Amendment Rules, 2024.**

Recruitment to the posts of Ayurvedic Medical Officer in the rank of Group-B under Health & Family Welfare Department.

Online applications are invited from the prospective candidates through the Proforma application to be made available on the website (<https://www.opsc.gov.in>). **The link for registration and payment of examination fee shall be available from 09.09.2026 to 09.10.2026 (5:00 P.M.) (Note: 09.10.2026 (5:00 P.M) is the last date/ closing date for submission of Registered Online Application)** for recruitment to **32 (Thirty-two)** posts of **Ayurvedic Medical Officer** in the rank of Group – B of Odisha Ayurvedic Medical Service under Health & Family Welfare Department in the Scale of Pay of Rs. 44,900/- in Level 10, Cell -1 of Pay Matrix under Rule-3 of the ORSP Rules, 2017 with usual Dearness and other Allowances as may be sanctioned by the Government of Odisha from time to time. The recruitment is to be conducted according to provisions mentioned in the Odisha Ayurvedic Medical Service (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 2013 and the Odisha Ayurvedic Medical Service (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Amendment Rules, 2024.

2. VACANCY POSITION:

Health & Family Welfare Department, Government of Odisha, after taking into account the sanctioned strength of different categories as per reservation percentage and men in position in each category, has filed a requisition to fill up the following number of vacant posts.

Out of the total **32** number of vacancies mentioned above, **01** post is reserved for **Persons with Disabilities (whose permanent disability is 40% or more)**. Candidates belonging to the category of Persons with Disabilities shall be adjusted against the category to which they belong. The details are given below: -

NOTE: -

- a) The candidates applying against SEBC Category (Non-Creamy Layer) must submit Caste Certificate issued by the Competent Authority not more than 03 years before the first date of submission of Online Application Form. Candidates furnishing SEBC certificate which is issued more than 03 years prior to the start date (09.09.2026) of submission of Online Application, shall not be considered under SEBC category. **The SEBC Certificate must be issued on or after 10.09.2023.**
- b) **PwD candidates must upload their Permanent Disability Certificate. Candidate with Temporary Disability will not be considered for reservation under PwD category.**
- c) Experience has shown that, some candidates obtain caste certificate etc. immediately ahead of the date of Application and upload the same along with Online Application, only to secure admission to the examination, which sometimes get cancelled subsequently on the grounds of inadmissibility etc. If any such cancellation of any uploaded certificate is detected at any stage of the recruitment examination or even subsequently, the candidature of such candidates will be cancelled, or recommendation be withdrawn as the case may be if the candidate has availed the benefits of Reservation.
- d) In case of non-availability of eligible/ suitable women candidate(s) belonging to the respective category, the unfilled vacancies of that category shall be filled up by eligible/ suitable male candidate(s) of the same category.
- e) Exchange of reservation between Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe will not be considered in the event of non-availability of eligible and suitable S.C. / S.T. candidates.
- f) The number of vacancies to be filled up on the basis of this recruitment is subject to change by the Government without Notice, depending upon the exigencies of public service at the discretion of the State Government.

3. AGE:

A candidate must have attained the age of **21(twenty-one)** years and must not be above the age of **42 (Forty-two)** years on the **1st day of January, 2026** i.e., he/she must have been born **not earlier than 2nd January, 1984 and not later than 1st January, 2005.**

Provided that the upper age limit prescribed above shall be relaxed by **five (05) years** for candidates belonging to the categories of Socially & Educationally Backward Classes (S.E.B.C.), Scheduled Castes (S.C.), Scheduled Tribes (S.T.), Women & Ex-Servicemen and by **10 (Ten) years** for Persons with Disabilities whose **permanent disability is forty percent (40%) or more.**

Persons with Disabilities belonging to SEBC/ SC/ ST categories are eligible for cumulative age relaxation benefit upto fifteen (15) years.

(SAVE AS PROVIDED ABOVE, THE AGE LIMITS PRESCRIBED CAN IN NO CASE BE RELAXED)

Date of birth entered in the High School Certificate or equivalent certificate issued by the concerned Board/Council will only be accepted by the Commission.

4. EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:

A candidate must possess a Bachelor's Degree in Ayurvedic Medicine and Surgery (B.A.M.S.) or equivalent Degree from an University or Institution recognized by Central Council of Indian Medicine. He must have registered himself/ herself under the Odisha State Council of Ayurvedic Medicines. **Provisional Medical Registration Certificate will not be entertained.**

NOTE – (i) The candidate must have completed his/ her compulsory rotatory internship/ Housemanship within the last date of submission of Online Application Form.

(ii) The Registration Certificate under Odisha State Council of Ayurvedic Medicines must have been issued prior to the last date of submission of Online Application Form.

5. KNOWLEDGE IN ODIA:

A candidate must be able to speak, read and write Odia and must have –

- i) Passed M.E. School or higher examination with Odia as a language subject; or
- ii) Passed Matriculation or equivalent examination with Odia as a medium of examination in non-language subject; or
- iii) Passed in Odia as a language subject in the final examination of Class VII from a school or educational institution recognized by the Government of Odisha or the Central Government; or
- iv) Passed a test in Odia in Middle English School standard conducted by the School & Mass Education Department of the Government of Odisha / Board of Secondary Education, Odisha.

6. EXAMINATION FEE, MODE OF PAYMENT & REFUND:

As per Odisha payment of recruitment examination fees and Refund Rules, 2025 published vide Government in G.A. & P.G. Department Notification No. 34124-GAD-SC-rules-0020/2025/Gen. dated 10.10.2025, **the candidates other than SC, ST and PWD category shall have to pay the Examination fees.**

The candidates other than SC, ST and PWD category shall have to pay the examination fee amounting to **Rs. 700/- (Rupees Seven Hundred) only** through online mode while filling the Online Application Form. The examination fees paid shall be **refunded only to those candidates who actually appear the Written Examination. Applications without payment of examination fees (except SC/ ST/ PWD candidates) will be taken as incomplete and outrightly be rejected.**

Refund shall be issued in due course after completion of the Written Examination. Refunds will be processed to the original mode of payment used at the time of the transaction by the candidate. (Credit Card, Debit Card, UPI, Net Banking, Wallet etc.).

However, the candidates shall have to furnish their bank account details i.e. Account Number, IFSC Code, Name of the Account Holder and Name of the Bank branch in the required field in the Online Application Form which will be required in case of failure of refund of money through the original mode of payment owing to technical glitches or other issues, if any. The Bank Account must remain valid/active. The onus of furnishing the correct bank account details lies with the candidates and the Commission (OPSC) shall not entertain any correspondence from any candidate in this regard.

7. METHOD OF SELECTION:

- a) The selection of candidates for recruitment to the posts of Ayurvedic Medical Officers shall be made on the basis of **Written Examination.**
- b) The **total marks** for the written examination shall be **200.**
- c) There shall be two papers i.e., Paper-I & Paper-II, each consisting of 100 questions and carrying 100 marks.
- d) The **duration** of each paper shall be **1 ½ hour.**
- e) **For each wrong answer 0.25 marks shall be deducted from the total marks awarded for correct answers**
- f) The questions paper will be objective with Multiple Choice Questions as per BAMS Curriculum.
- g) The course syllabus is appended at **Annexure-A** of this advertisement.

The Commission shall prepare a list of successful candidates in order of merit on the basis of Written Examination, which shall be equal to the number of advertised vacancies.

Provided that, if two or more candidates secure equal marks then the candidate securing higher marks in the BAMS Examination shall find place above the others in the merit list and in case marks obtained in BAMS examination is also the same, the candidate elder in age shall be placed above the younger.

Note: -i) The qualifying mark is **50% for UR & SEBC** candidates and **45% for PwD** category and **40% for ST & SC** category of candidates

ii) Any details relating to this recruitment like cut-off marks, answer keys, individual marks etc. shall only be declared on the website of the Commission after publication of the final results and select list.

8. DATE OF WRITTEN EXAMINATION:

The Written Examination will be held on **22.11.2026 (Sunday)**. The detailed Schedule and Centre of Examination will be notified in due course.

N.B.: After completion of the Written Examination, the Provisional Answer Key of the Papers shall be uploaded in the Website soon after the written examination inviting suggestions/objections, if any, from the candidates. Those candidates who do not challenge the Provisional Answer Key shall forfeit their right to agitate the matter subsequently in any forum or in any other manner.

9. PLACE OF EXAMINATION:

The venue of the Written Examination for the posts of Ayurvedic Medical Officer will be located at Kataka/Bhubaneswar.

10. OTHER ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:

- (i) The candidate must be a citizen of India;
- (ii) A candidate if married must not have more than one spouse living provided that the State Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person or there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.
- (iii) Government servants, whether temporary or permanent, are eligible to apply provided that they possess the requisite qualification and are within the prescribed age-limit as provided under Para-3 & 4 of the Advertisement. They must inform their respective Head of Offices in writing regarding submission of their applications for this recruitment and furnish "No Objection Certificate" during document verification. So the candidates must obtain NOC well in advance;
- (iv) If a candidate has at any time, been debarred for a certain period/chance(s) by the Odisha Public Service Commission or other State Public Service Commission or U.P.S.C. from appearing at any examination/ viva voce test, he/she will not be eligible for such recruitment for that specified period/chance(s).

- (v) **A candidate must have to register himself/ herself under the Odisha State Council of Ayurvedic Medicines on or before the Last date of Submission of online application form.**
- (vi) A candidate who claims change in his/her name after having passed the High School Certificate Examination or equivalent examination, is required to furnish copy of publication of the changed name in local leading daily newspaper as well as copy of notification in the Gazette in support of his/her change of name.
- (vii) **Only those candidates, who possess the requisite qualifications, are within the prescribed age limit & fulfil other eligibility conditions strictly etc. by the closing date of submission of online application form, will be considered eligible;**
- (viii) Every candidate selected for appointment shall be examined by the Medical Board. A candidate, who does not satisfy the requirement after medical examination, shall not be appointed to the service.

11. IMPORTANT POINTS:

- a) The provisions of the Odisha Conduct of Examination Act, 1988 (Odisha Act-2 of 1988) are applicable to the examination conducted by the Odisha Public Service Commission. Any violation of the above Act and violation of “**Instructions to candidates**” (as provided in the advertisement, application form, Brochure, Admission Certificate & Answer Script etc.) will be seriously viewed and disciplinary action will be taken against the concerned candidates as deemed proper.
- b) A candidate found guilty of seeking support for his/her candidature by offering illegal gratification or applying pressure on any person connected with the conduct of the recruitment process or found indulging in any type of malpractice in course of the selection or otherwise, shall, in addition to rendering himself/herself liable to criminal prosecution, be disqualified not only for the recruitment for which he/she is a candidate, but also may be debarred, either permanently or for a specified period, from any recruitment or selection to be conducted by the Commission;
- c) **Online applications submitted to OPSC, if found to be incomplete in any respect, are liable for rejection without entertaining any correspondence with the applicants on that score;**
- d) **Admission to Written Examination / Document Verification will be provisional. If on verification at any stage before or after the Written Examination/ Document Verification Publication, it is found that a candidate does not fulfil all the eligibility conditions, his/her candidature will be liable for rejection. Decision of the Commission with regard to eligibility or otherwise of a candidate shall be final;**

- e) This advertisement should not be construed as binding on the Appointing Authority to make an appointment.
- f) **Reservation and Relaxation etc. meant for S.C. / S.T. by Birth and SEBC are admissible to the Scheduled Castes / Scheduled Tribes and Socially & Educationally Backward Classes of Odisha only;**
- g) Community (caste status) once mentioned by the candidates under the appropriate box of the online application form, will be treated as final and the same not be changed subsequently under any circumstances.
- h) **Any misrepresentation or suppression of information by the candidate in the online application form will result in cancellation of his/her candidature or penalty, as decided by the Commission shall be imposed on the candidate;**
- i) Mere empanelment in the select list shall not confer any right for appointment unless the Appointing Authority is satisfied after making such enquiry as may be deemed necessary that the candidate is suitable in all respects for appointment to the Service.
- j) No request for withdrawal of candidature and change of category will be entertained under any circumstances.
- k) All persons appointed under the Government of Odisha on or after 1st January, 2005, shall not be eligible for pension as defined under Sub-rule (1) of Rule-3 of the Odisha Civil Service (Pension) Rules, 1992; but shall be covered by the defined Contributory Pension Scheme in accordance with the Odisha Civil Services (Pension) Amendment Rules, 2005;
- l) **Submission of NPS application is mandatory for all recommended candidates at the time of joining in Government services.**
- m) Candidates are requested to bring the copies of certificates and other requisite documents as stated under Para-12 of this Advertisement at the time of Document Verification.

12. CERTIFICATES/DOCUMENTS TO BE ATTACHED:

Candidates who qualify in the written examination will be required to bring with them the hard copy of online application form along with copies of following certificates/documents and originals of the same for verification of their eligibility as per terms and conditions of the advertisement, the date of which shall be notified later on in due course, failing which his/her application shall be rejected for the said post. The candidates are required to mention on each copy of documents **"Submitted by me and Certified as Genuine and has not been cancelled"** and put their **full signature and date on the same.**

They must not attach the original certificates to their applications.

- (i) Four (04) recent passport size photographs within six months (unsigned & unattested) which has been uploaded with online application form;
- (ii) H.S.C. or equivalent certificate in support of declaration of age issued by the concerned Board/Council;
- (iii) B.A.M.S. Degree Certificate issued by the concerned University;
- (iv) Mark-lists in support of B.A.M.S. Degree passed including fail marks, if any, issued by the concerned Board/ Council/ University;

NOTE 1:

- (a) **The candidates have to upload their relevant documents as required by the system while filling up online application form, failing which their candidature shall be rejected.**
- (b) **The marksheets of all Semesters including the Back Paper marksheets (if any), Internship Completion Certificate, Final BAMS Certificate, Permanent Medical Registration Certificate issued by Odisha State Council of Ayurvedic Medicines & Attempt Certificate should be uploaded at the time of Registration.**
- (c) **All the aforesaid documents are required to be merged into a single PDF file within a size of Maximum 10 MB and uploaded at the time of submission of online application form.**
- (d) **Candidates who have not been awarded percentage of marks, but only "GRADE MARKS", should, along with their applications, produce the conversion certificate from the concerned University indicating the actual equivalent percentage of marks and the conversion formula failing which, their applications are liable to be rejected.**
- (v) **Permanent Medical Registration Certificate under the Odisha State Council of Ayurvedic Medicines. (Provisional Registration shall not be entertained).**
- (vi) **Compulsory Rotatory Housemanship/ Internship Completion Certificate within last date of submission of online application form.**
- (vii) **Caste Certificate by birth in support of claim as S.E.B.Cs./ S.Cs./ S.Ts. wherever applicable (Please see Note-2);**
- (viii) **Required Odia Test Pass Certificate / Certificate issued by School Principal in case passed in Odia Language in Class-VII or Middle English School Standard / Certificate issued by Board of Secondary Education, Odisha;**
- (ix) **Permanent Disability Certificate (indicating percentage disability i.e., 40% or more) issued by the concerned Medical Board wherever applicable;**
- (x) **Ex-Servicemen claiming age relaxation are required to submit/ upload Release Certificate issued as per Orissa Ex-Servicemen (Recruitment to State Civil Services and Posts) Rules, 1985 vide GA Department. Notification No. 22586/Gen, dt. 16.10.1985;**
- (xi) **No Objection Certificate issued by the Competent Authority in case of a Government servant.**

- (xii) If a candidate claims to possess qualification, equivalent to the prescribed qualification, the rule/authority (with number and date) under which it is so treated, must be furnished with the Application Form.
- (xiii) Any proof of photo Identity. Preferred ID is Aadhar Card.

NOTE 2:

- (i) Candidates claiming to be belonging to S.C. /S.T. categories of Odisha by birth & S.E.B.C. are required to submit copy of the relevant Caste Certificate issued by the competent authority in the prescribed form.
- (ii) As per the prevailing norms, the SEBC Certificate issued by Competent Authority for claiming reservation under SEBC (Non-Creamy Layer) is valid for 03 (three) years only. Hence, the SEBC Certificate must be issued on or after 10.09.2023. The SEBC certificate issued before 10.09.2023 will not be treated as valid and the candidate will forfeit his/her claim for reservation under SEBC category.
- (iii) Women candidates belonging to S.C. / S.T. categories by birth and S.E.B.C are required to submit Caste Certificates showing "daughter of". Caste Certificates by virtue of marriage (i.e. showing "wife of") are not acceptable and liable for rejection.
- (iv) OBC certificate will not be accepted in lieu of SEBC certificate.
- (v) Community (Caste status) once mentioned by the candidates in the online application form shall not be changed under any circumstances.

The Competent Authorities are as prescribed by the Government of Odisha under relevant Reservation Rules.

NOTE 3:

BAMS Degree Certificate, Internship Completion Certificate, Permanent Medical Registration Certificate, Caste Certificate, Odia Test Pass Certificate, Permanent Disability Certificate of Person with Disabilities (indicating % of permanent disability) and Release Certificate of Ex-Servicemen [issued as per Orissa Ex-Servicemen (Recruitment to State Civil Services and Posts) Rules, 1985 vide GA Department. Notification No. 22586/Gen, dt. 16.10.1985] must have been issued by the Competent Authority on or before the date of submission of the online application form by the candidate.

13. GROUND OF REJECTION OF APPLICATION:

Applications of candidates will be rejected by the Commission on any of the following grounds: -

- (a) In-complete online application form including non-uploading of required documents in the online application form.
- (b) Non-submission of hard copy of online application form at the time of verification of original documents.
- (c) Declaration not signed (full signature) by the candidate in the hard copy of online application form.
- (d) Not passing Odia Test (M.E. standard)/ not furnishing Odia Test pass evidence by the date for submission of online application form as required under Para -5 of the Advertisement.
- (e) Not coming within the age limit as mentioned in Para-3 of the advertisement (Age relaxation shall not be allowed to P.W.D. candidates with less than 40% permanent disability).
- (f) Not having prescribed requisite qualification by the date of submission of online application form as provided under Para-4 of the advertisement.
- (g) Non-payment of examination fee, (wherever applicable), as provided under Para - 6 of Advertisement.
- (h) Not furnishing copies of certificates/documents as provided under Para-12 of the Advertisement.
- (i) Submission/ uploading of wrong information / false information/ forged or fake or manipulated certificates/ testimonials with respect to qualification/ Age/ Category status (SEBC/ SC/ ST/ PWD/ Ex-Servicemen/Women)/ OT pass evidence etc.
- (j) Suppression of facts / information about eligibility, if any.
- (k) Any such certificates as provided under Para-12 of the Advertisement issued after the last date for submission of Online Application Form will not be entertained to consider eligibility.
- (l) Application received through any other mode (except Online through proforma Application to be made available on WEBSITE OF OPSC).

NB: Application /candidature of a candidate shall be rejected at any stage of recruitment process, whenever discrepancy is noticed/ detected.

14.HOW TO APPLY:

- a) Candidates must carefully go through the details of this Advertisement available in the Website of OPSC before filling up online application form.
- b) Candidates must apply online through the concerned Website of the OPSC **<http://opsc.gov.in>**. Applications received through **any other mode** would not be accepted and summarily rejected.
- c) **Before filling up the online application form, the candidates must go through detailed instructions available at OPSC portal.**

- d) The online application form is automated and system driven & will guide the candidate seamlessly in filling the application. The requisite options shall be enabled and information shall be asked as per data furnished by the candidate. Before filling up the information, ensure that accurate information is fed. The candidate must also verify the submitted copy of online application after its submission. If the candidate further wants to modify any information, she/he has to cancel the application and apply again within the last date of submission of application.
- e) Candidates are requested to upload the scanned image of latest passport size photograph along with scanned image of his/her full signature and scanned image of Left-hand Thumb Impression (LTI) in the online application form. Uploaded photograph, Specimen (full) signature and LTI must be clearly identifiable / visible; otherwise, the application of the candidate is liable to be rejected by the Commission and no representation from the candidate will be entertained.
- f) Candidates should keep at least four copies of latest passport size photograph which is uploaded to the online application form for future use.
- g) *On successful submission of the online Registration, a unique **"Permanent Public Service Account Number (PPSAN)"** will be assigned to the applicant.
